SAFETY MEETING SAFETY GLASSES

1. Always make sure PPE is properly rated for the job
2. Wear Safety Glasses for specific hazard that you are going to work with.
3. Make sure it doesn't obstruct your view.
4. Make sure it fits properly
5. Look for "Z87+" on the frame or lenses as an indicator of impact protection.
6. Wear vented safety goggles for caustic dust, such as cement dust, and wear non-vented goggles for chemicals.
7. Inspect before you use it.
8. Take care of your eye protection.
9. Replace it when damaged.
10. If injured, do not rub your eyes.
11. For dust, small particles, or chemicals, use the eyewash station.
Rinse with clean water for at least 15 to 20 minutes.
12. In case of injury, and objects in the eyes, seek medical attention; do not wash out your eyes or try to remove objects yourself.
13. Never wear a damaged safety glasses
14. Never wear safety glasses if it does not have ANSI Z87 on the frame.
