SAFETY MEETING - ENGLISH AERIAL LIFT MACHINE

MAN LIFT

1. Inspect the machine and the work area before begin to work (Always 10 feet away from power lines)
2. Check if there is any potential hazards such as holes, bumps, or debris or anything that could cause the lift to tip over.
3. Always follow the manufacturer's instructions
4. Check all operating and emergency controls.
5. Do not exceed the manufacturer's slope limits.
6. Avoid contact with overhead hazards.
7. Stay at least 10 feet away from power lines.
8. Close lift-platform doors.
9. Make sure guard rails is in good condition.
10. Inspect and wear Safety Harness.
11. Never seat at guardrail, always stand on the floor of the bucket.
12. Do not climb on or lean over the guardrails.
13. Never exceed the load limits
14. Never move an aerial lift with the lift extended
